Faith-Based Meditation




What is Faith-Based Meditation: it is a form of prayer in which a structured attempt is made to become aware of and reflect upon the revelations of God. The process of deliberately focusing on specific thoughts (such as a passage from a religious text) and reflecting on their meaning in the context of the love of God.




Traditional definition of Meditation: to engage in mental exercise (such as concentration on one's breathing or repetition of a mantra) for the purpose of reaching a heightened level of spiritual awareness

Faith-Based Meditation: instead of clearing one's mind to reach awareness one reaches a heightened level of awareness by filling your mind with God



Examples of Prayers in The Christian Faith



Morning Prayer

O Lord, grant me to meet the coming day in peace. Help me in all thing to rely upon Your holy will. In every hour of the day, reveal Your will to me. Bless my dealing with all who surround me. Teach me to treat all that comes to me throughout the day with peace of soul and with firm conviction that Your will governs all. In all my deeds and words, guide my thoughts and feelings. In unforeseen events, let me not forget that all are sent by You. Teach me to act firmly and wisely, without embittering and embarrassing others. Give me strength to bear the fatigue of the coming day with all that it shall bring. Direct my will, teach me to pray, pray You Yourself in me. Amen.



A prayer for protection/strength:

O Lord, Thou who steadied the hand of Peter as he began to sink on the stormy sea, if Thou are with me, no one is against me. Grant to me the shield of faith and the mighty armor of the Holy Spirit to protect me and guide me to do Thy will. The future I put into Thy hands, O Lord, and I follow Thee to a life in Christ.



A prayer for time of trouble:

Examples of Islamic Duas (Prayers)



Morning Dua:

Whenever a Muslim wakes up from sleep, he should express gratitude to Allah for allowing him to live and continue worshiping Him.

اَلْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَحْيَانَا بَعْدَ مَا أَمَاتَنَا وَإِلَيْهِ النُّشُورُ

Transliteration:

Alhamdu lillaahil-lathee 'ahyaanaa ba'da maa 'amaatanaa wa'ilayhin-nushoor.

Translation:


Praise be to Allah who resurrected us after He made us die. And to Him will be the (people's) emergence (from graves)

Transliteration:

Alhamdu lillaahil-lathee 'aafaanee fee jasadee, wa radda 'alayya roohee, wa 'athina lee bithikrihi.

Translation:

Praise be to Allah who granted me well-being in my body, returned my soul to me, and permitted me to remember Him.




DUA FOR OVERCOMING HARDSHIP AND ADVERSITY:

In Surah Anbiya, Ayat 87 it says, "And [mention] the man of the fish, when he went off in anger and thought that We would not decree [anything] upon him. And he called out within the darknesses..."

Transliteration: la ilaha illa anta subhanaka inneekuntu mina aththalimeen

Translation: There is no deity except You; exalted are You. Indeed, I have been of the wrongdoers.



Dua for strength from Allah:



اَللّٰهُمَّ قَوِّنِيۡ فِيۡهِ عَلٰى إِقَامَةِ أَمۡرِكُ، وَاَذِقۡنِي فِيۡهِ حَلاوَةَ ذِكْرِكَ، وَاَوْزِعْنِيۡ فِيۡهِ لِادآءِ شُكْرِكَ بِكَرَمِكَ، وَاحْفَظْني فِيۡهِ بِحِفْظِكَ وَسَتْرِكَ، يَاۤ أَبۡصَرَ النَّاظِرِيۡنَ

Transliteration: Allahumma qawwini fihi 'ala iqamati amrik, wa aziqni fihi halawata dhikrik, wa awzi'ni fihi liadai syukrika bikaramik wahfazhni fihi bihifzhik wasatrik ya Absharan nazirin.

Translation: O ALLAH! Strengthen me in it to perform Your commands, enable me in it to taste the sweetness of mentioning Your Name, enable me in it to truly thank You with Your generosity, and safeguard me in it with Your safeguard and cover, O most seeing One!

Dua Seeking Forgiveness

َ اللَّهُمَّ أَنْتَ رَبِّي لَّا إِلَهَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ، خَلَقْتَنِي وَأَنَا عَبْدُكِ، وَأَنَا عَلَى عَهْدِكَ وَوَعْدِكَ مَا اسْتَطَعْتُ، أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شَرِّ مَا صَنَعْتُ، أَبُوءُ لَكَ بِنِعْمَتِكَ عَلَيَّ، وَأَبُوءُ بِذَنْبِي فَاغْفِر لِي فَإِنَّهُ لَا يَغْفِرُ الذَّنُوبَ إِلَّا أَنْتَ

Transliteration: Allaahumma 'Anta Rabbee laa 'ilaaha 'illaa 'Anta, khalaqtanee wa 'anaa 'abduka, wa 'anaa 'alaa 'ahdika wa wa'dika mas-tata'tu, 'a'oothu bika min sharri maa sana'tu, 'aboo'u laka bini'matika 'alayya, wa 'aboo'u bithanbee faghfir lee fa'innahu laa yaghfiruth-thunooba 'illaa 'Anta.

Translation: O Allāh, You are my Lord, and there is no (true) god but You. You created me, and I am Your servant, and I try to fulfill my covenant and promise to You as much as I am able. I seek Your protection from the evil of my doings. I admit to Your favor upon me, and I confess my sins to You, so forgive me, because no one forgives sins but You.




Dua seeking protection

Transliteration: Bismillaahil-lathee laa yadhurru ma'as-mihi shay'un fil-'ardhi wa laa fis-samaa'i wa Huwas-Samee 'ul- 'Aleem.

Translation: (I seek protection) with the name of Allah-the One who, with His name, nothing can cause harm on Earth or in the Heaven. He is the All-Hearing and All-Knowing.




Extra Chrisitan Prayers
